Two Requirements to Approve a Countywide Charter

- 1.a) Students will benefit from the charter
- 1.b) Students will be better served by countywide than single district

- 2.a) Charter presents sound educational practice
- 2.b) Valid reasons why school could not be in one district



Evaluative Criteria for Countywide Charters:

- 1. Ability to successfully implement the program
- 2. Sound educational program
- 3. Required signatures
- 4. Affirmations
- Reasonably comprehensive description of required elements



Evaluative Criteria for Countywide Charters

- 1) Ability to successfully implement the program
 - Governance structure
 - Programmatic viability
 - Fiscal viability



Evaluative Criteria for Countywide Charters

- 2) Sound educational program
- Analysis: Strong, research-based educational program
- Capacity: Staffing, PD, reading, special ed, EL, partnership, UCP, outreach



Evaluative Criteria for Countywide Charters

- 3) Required signatures
- 4) Affirmation of each required condition
- 5) Reasonably comprehensive description of the 16 required elements



Reasonably Comprehensive Description of Elements

Element 1: Sound educational program

Analysis: Strong, research-based educational program

Capacity: Staffing, PD, reading, special ed, EL,

partnership, UCP, outreach



Reasonably Comprehensive Description of Elements

Element 2: Measurable student outcomes

Analysis: Strong, all required metrics.

Capacity: EL access to CCSS and ELD standards



Reasonably Comprehensive Description of Elements

Element 7: Health and Safety

Analysis: Adequate, need detail for health and safety

Capacity: Health and safety plan and dates for policies
