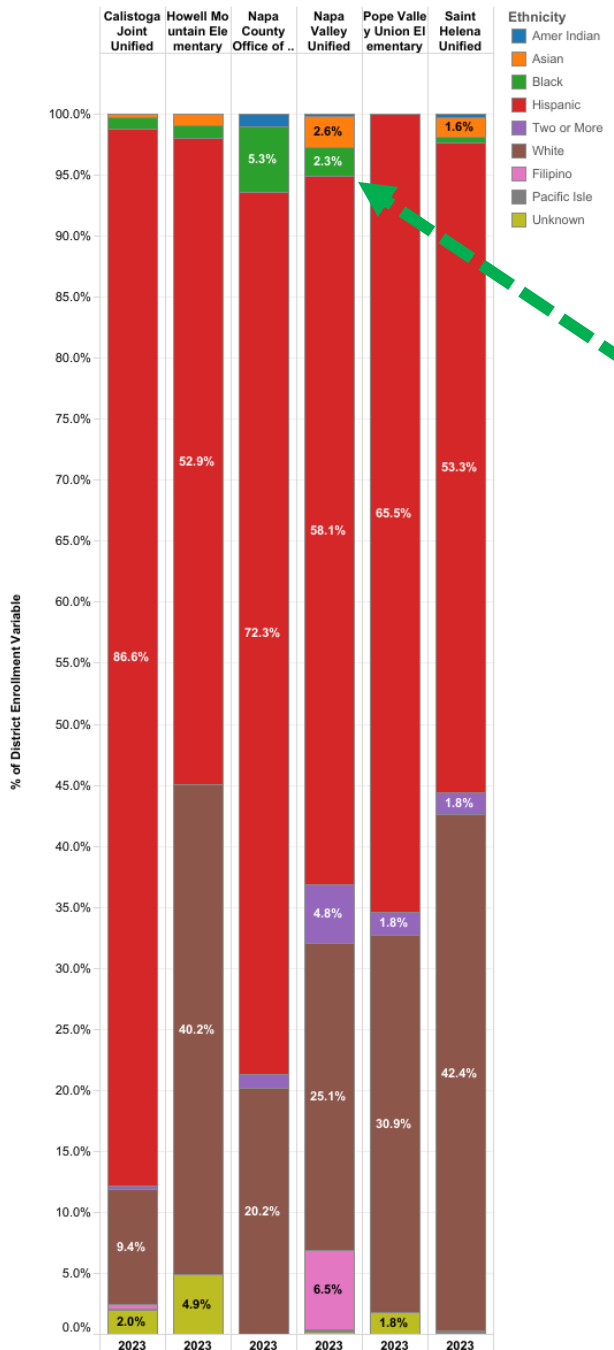

# About the Data

- NVUSD is the only district in Napa County with a large enough group of Black students to show up on California's accountability measures (minimum n size = 30). Thus, the data shown is only for NVUSD.

- Napa's outcome data for Black students is similar to the state and nation in terms of the outcome gaps relative to other student groups.

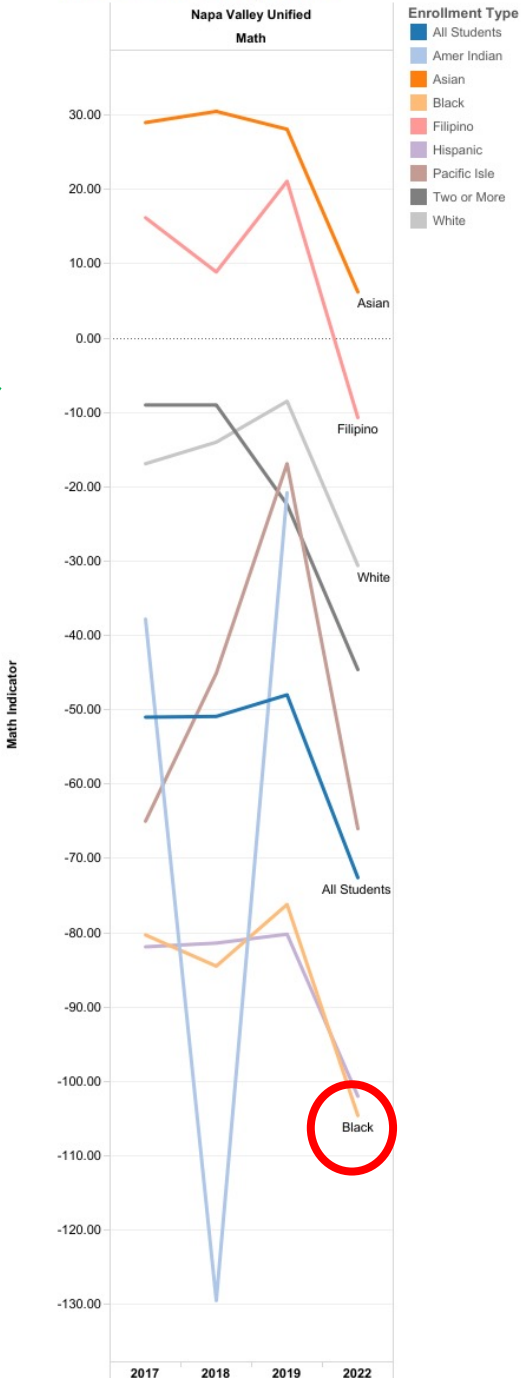

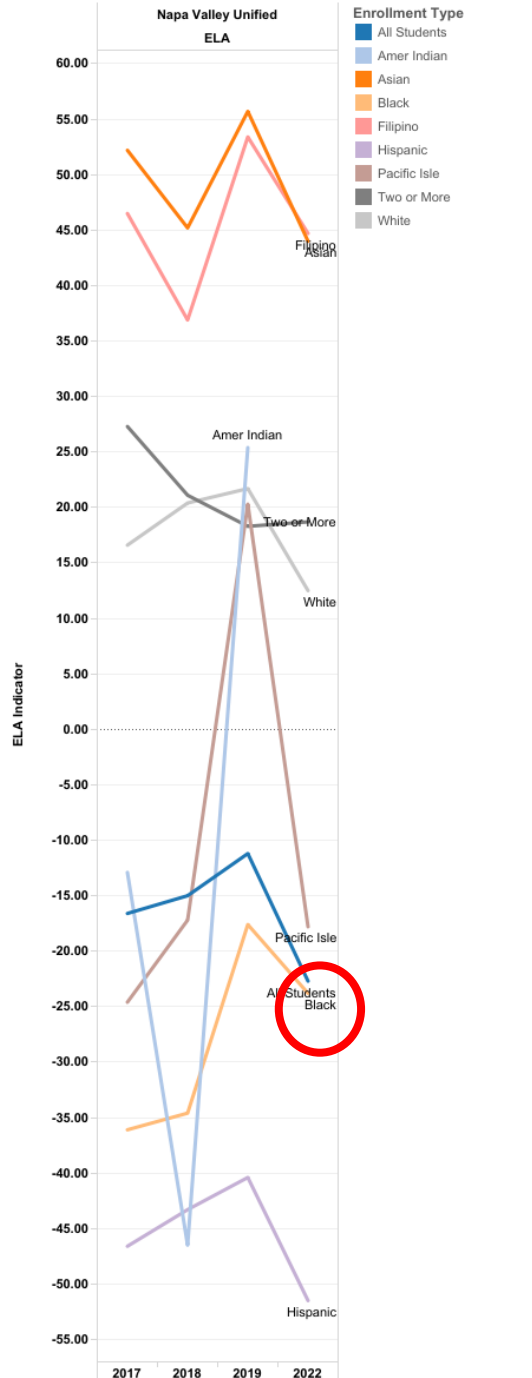
### Math Indicator Trends - District

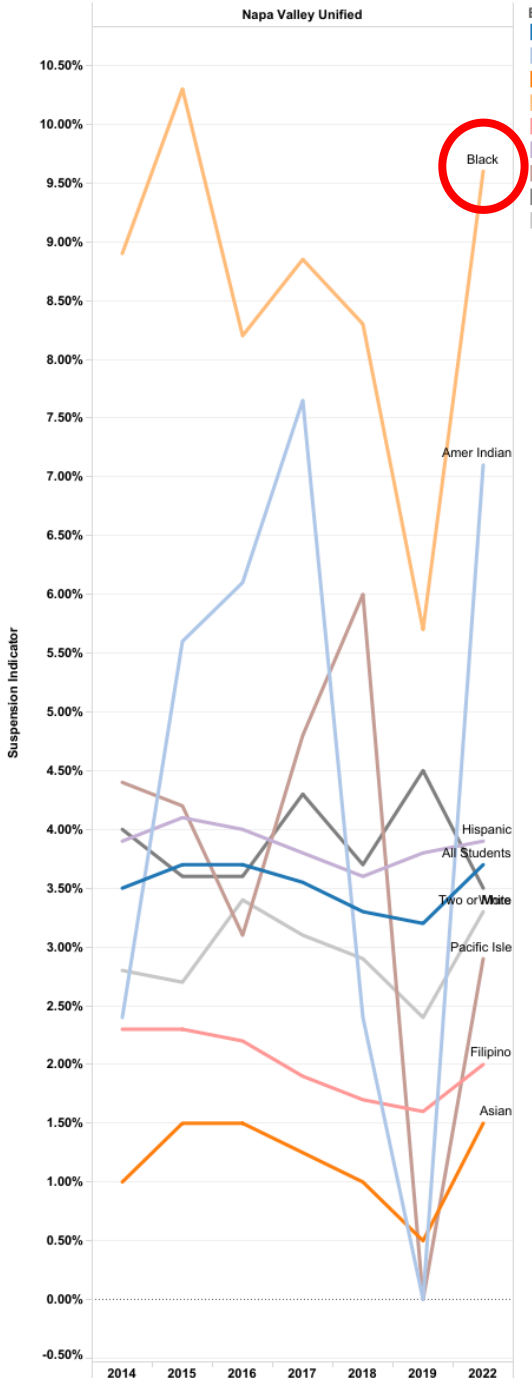
### ELA Indicator Trends - District

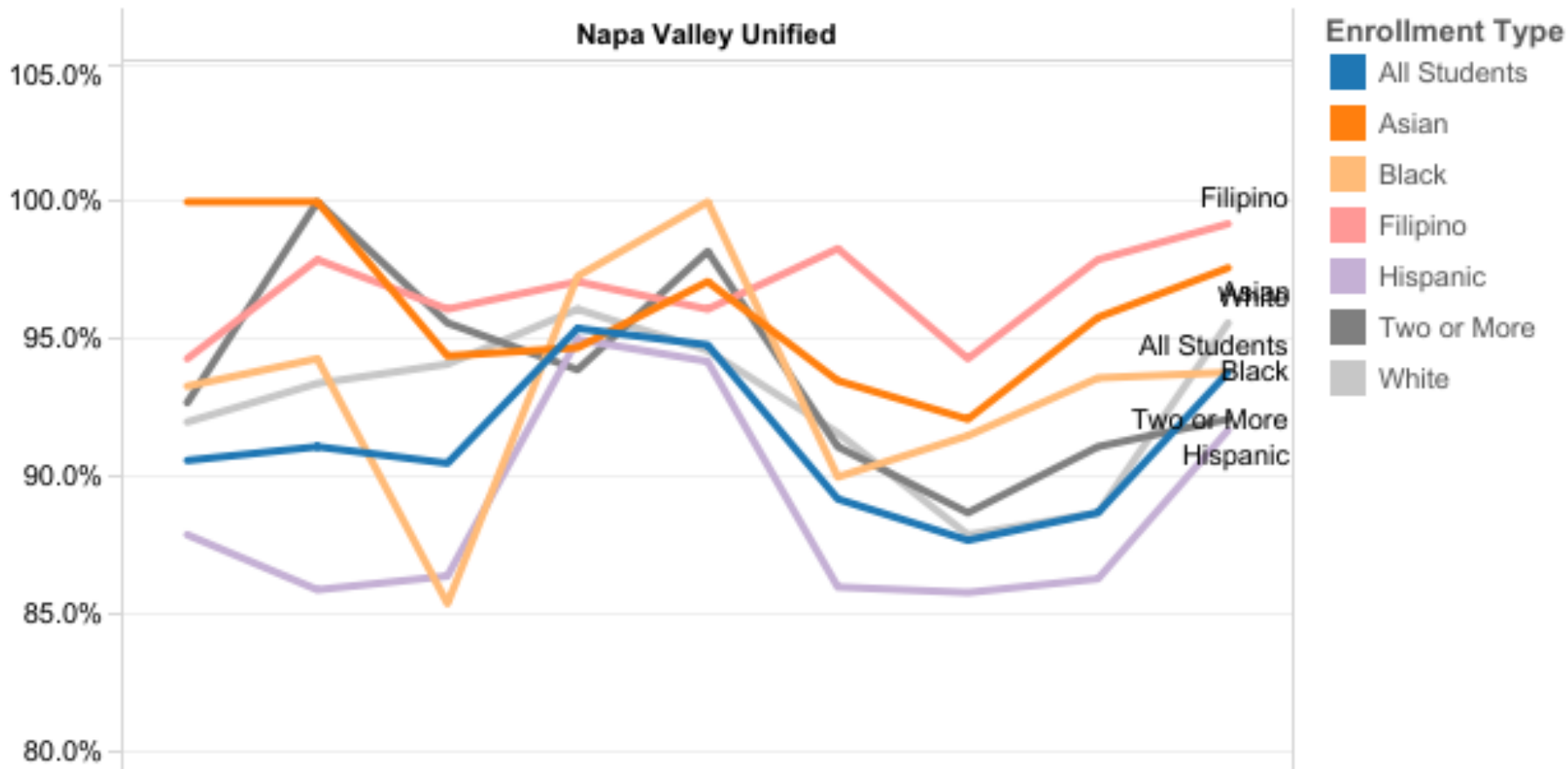
### Suspension Rate Trends - District
