



Notice of Nondiscrimination

It is against the law for organizations that receive federal financial assistance from AmeriCorps to discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, disability, sexual orientation, age, political affiliation, religion, parental or marital status, genetic information, military service, pregnancy. It is also unlawful to retaliate against any person who, or organization that, files a complaint about such discrimination. In addition to filing a complaint with local and state agencies that are responsible for resolving discrimination complaints, you may bring a complaint to the attention of AmeriCorps.
