- Stipends for earning a new family child care license

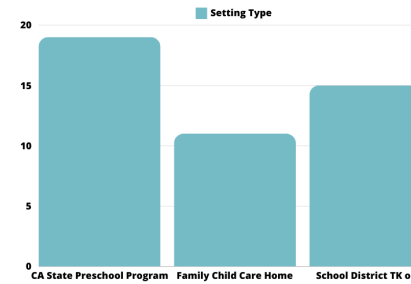

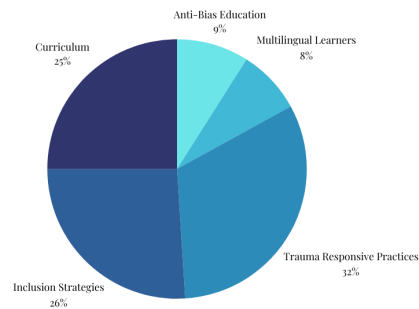
